At Woolpit Health Centre we are proud to operate a 'total triage' model. Every patient access request, whether online, telephone or walk-in, is clinically assessed and triaged by our 'on the day' GP team. A senior GP mentor who is always available to guide clinical decisions.

Requests are prioritised based on their level of urgency, then assigned to the healthcare professional best suited to meet individual needs. This may result in an urgent or routine call or appointment or self-care/signpost to other services.

In the 12 months since we switched our online request service to Anima, we have received over 45,000 requests, an average of 175 per day (Monday – Friday). Approximately one third of these requests are completed by our reception team on behalf of patients who telephone or walk-in.

Andi, our new Virtual Care Navigator!

On Thursday 5th February 2026 we launched a new automated system called Andi, designed to help improve how we manage patient requests and phone calls.

Andi is a Virtual Care Navigator and has been created by the same team behind Anima. We will be trialling over the next 3 months.

What is Virtual Care Navigation?

When you call the surgery, instead of waiting in a queue, you can speak to Andi, who will ask you questions, take down your request and send it to the triage team for review.

Benefits for Patients

- No need to wait in a call queue.
- A quick and easy way to submit your request.
- Fast and efficient triage.

Benefits for the Health Centre

- Frees up staff time to focus on patient care.
- Helps us manage requests fairly and efficiently.
- Reduces waiting times and phone line pressure.

A quick note: Andi isn't a robotic sounding voice – he sounds quite natural! This may feel a little unusual at first, but we encourage you to give it a try.

The meeting was attended by 9 Parish Councillors and Suffolk County Councillor, Andy Mellen. Apologies had been received from District Cllr Richardson.

This is a **summary** of the meeting. All papers are on the Parish Council section of the Tostock-pc.gov.uk website

There were several topics for discussion at the meeting. These included the management of the Tostock website. A villager had come forward with some ideas and Cllrs Callow and Sharkey will meet with him to see how the website can be improved without making it too onerous for one person.

There was an update on the Village Hall Improvement plans provided by Graham McDowell (Chairman) with input his fellow Trustees/Committee members (Bee Baully, Billy Gray and Rosemary Lister).

It is not always known what the Parish Council uses its funds to pay for, for the benefit of the village and the residents. Some of the items it pays for include the Speed Indicator Devices, the Litter picker and dog bin emptying. The Chronicle is paid for by the Parish Council although advertising does help reduce the cost to the residents.

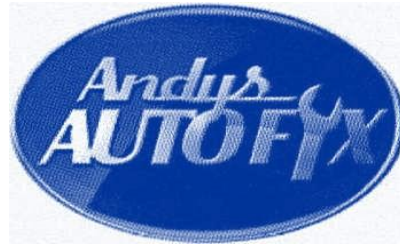
